THE EMMY® AWARDS



The National Capital Chesapeake Bay Chapter of the National Academy of Television Arts & Sciences recognizes outstanding individual achievement in the National Capital Chesapeake Bay region by conferring annual awards of merit.

The Emmy® Award is intended to recognize excellence. Therefore, in each category, one award, more than one award or no award may be given. The Awards Committee wants to remind NCCB members of the importance and honor of the nomination itself.

This year news, program and individual craft entries were judged online and in person by panels in Heartland, Lone Star, Mid-Atlantic, Ohio Valley, Rocky Mountain Southwest, Pacific Southwest, and Suncoast. The National Capital Chesapeake Bay Chapter's Awards Committee reviewed the unidentified totals prepared by the Certified Public Accounting firm of Bishop Farmer and Co., LLP for the purpose of determining the number of awards to be given.

HOW THE EMMY® JUDGING PROCESS WORKS

The Emmy® Award celebrates excellence in television with the announcement of the nominations in May and the awarding of statuettes in June. In December, January, and the early weeks of February, our Chapter receives hundreds of entries in 125 categories. After a thorough review by the Awards Committee members, the entries are divided up among other NATAS Chapters. They are screened and judged online, or in-person at Super Panels, by seasoned TV station staff, production companies, and independents who are experienced in the categories they have agreed to judge. This year, seven chapters judged our entries and in turn, we will judge their entries throughout the year.

Programming and News categories have a high score of 30; Crafts have a high score of 20. When the scores come in, the accounting firm of Bishop Farmer and Co., LLP translates the scores into percentages. So when it comes time for the Awards Committee to evaluate whether a category has Emmy® recipients and nominees, they get a blind category with a long list of percentages. After several years of doing it this way, the National Awards Committee has devised certain cut offs for scores that determine whether a category has Emmy® recipients and nominees. As a general guideline, entries that score 90% or above are awarded an Emmy® and those that score 80% or above receive a Nomination.

Kristen Berset-Harris is host of Great Day Washington on WUSA9. Kristen spent 6 years as WUSA9 Sports Anchor before joining the team at Great Day Washington. She still keeps up on all the sports news, while bringing viewers the latest and greatest that

the DC area has to offer.

In June 2017, Kristen was honored by the National Capital Chesapeake Bay Chapter of the Emmy Awards with the Ted Yates Award. It's the chapter's 'Profile of Courage' award given to professionals in the news business who have exhibited bravery on and off the job. Kristen returned to WUSA9 in August 2017 after completing treatment for her second bout with breast cancer, and continues to be a strong advocate for awareness and early detection.

Kristen's career began on the white sandy beaches of her home state of Florida. Kristen was a news anchor at WJHG in Panama City, Fla., and co-host of the Professional Tarpon Tournament Series, a fishing show broadcast around the nation.

She and the rest of the Tarpon Crew traveled to Kuwait and Iraq, toured the countries and put on a fishing tournament for over 400 U.S. servicemen and women and their allies at Z Lake on Victory Base Complex in Baghdad. Kristen won the Florida Chapter Associated Press award for a 4 part series of her trip called "Journey to Freedom."

Her journey then took her from the Sunshine State to Charm City, shifting her focus 100% to Sports. Kristen was Weekend Sports Anchor for WBFF in Baltimore, MD and part of a team that won the Chesapeake Bay Region Associated Press award for Best Year Round Sports Coverage.

Kristen was also Host of the Emmy winning show 'Ravens Report", the flagship program for the Baltimore Ravens that showcases life in the NFL.

Kristen is a graduate of the University of Florida with a degree in Telecommunications and continues to be an avid Gators fan. She was the 2004 Miss Florida USA and a semi-finalist in the Miss USA finals.

HOST | ANDREA ROANE

Andrea Roane has been with WUSA9 since 1981, and has anchored every news shift from morning to afternoon and late night. She currently anchors WUSA at Noon and is WUSA9's Health reporter.

A multi-EMMY and GRACIE Award

winner, Andrea has covered a wealth of hard news stories, from politics, the arts, education and sports to women's health and women's empowerment issues. She has interviewed newsmakers, entertainers, politicians, plus your neighbors, friends, and colleagues all over the DMV. Her reporting has taken her across the U-S, overseas to Jerusalem, the Virgin Islands, and Havana, Cuba.

Andrea is best known to viewers for her passionate reporting on breast health issues and promoting the importance of Early Detection in the fight against breast cancer. Andrea's commitment to women's health and community service have been recognized with countless national and local awards.

For her outstanding work as a journalist and for her community service, Andrea was awarded the 2015 Board of Governors Award by the National Academy of Television Arts & Sciences, National Capital Chesapeake Bay Chapter.

In 2014, Andrea was inducted into the DC Hall of Fame. Andrea received the 2012 "Faith Does Justice Award" from Catholic Charities of the Washington Archdiocese.

Andrea was named a 2010 Rebecca Lipkin Honoree for Media Distinction at the first annual Susan G. Komen For the Cure's "Honoring the Promise Gala." Andrea has also been honored by the Sibley Memorial Hospital Foundation with its Community Service Award in 2009 for being a passionate breast cancer advocate.

In 2006, she was named one of Washingtonian Magazine's "Washingtonians Of The Year" for her continued work on breast cancer awareness through her Buddy Check 9 initiative.

Among her many community affiliations, Andrea is; a member of the Capital Beast Care Center Community Advisory Council, co-chair of the Kennedy Center's Community & Friends Board; a Trustee Emeritus of the Catholic University of America; a Dame of the Order of Malta; a Sustaining Director of the Prevent Cancer Foundation; a member of the board of the National Museum of Women in the Arts; a member of the International Women's Forum, DC; a member of the Metropolitan (DC) Chapter of the Links, Incorporated; and a lifetime member of the NAACP.

TED YATES AWARD

Ted Yates was a NBC News producer who traveled the world on assignment. Killed in the practice of his profession, he is remembered for his achievements in journalism. This award is given to an individual who has demonstrated outstanding professional and personal qualities in their contribution to the National Capital Chesapeake Bay region's television news and public affairs.



DOREEN GENTZLER

Anchor/ Medical Reporter NBC4

Doreen Gentzler anchors News4 at 6 and News4 at 11. She also serves as the station's medical reporter, filing cutting-edge health reports for all of the station's newscasts.

For 28 years, Gentzler anchored with Jim Vance, making them one of the longest-tenured anchor teams in the country. Vance died in July 2017, and Gentzler led NBC4's on-air tributes.

Born in DC and educated in Arlington, Gentzler is proud of her deep roots in the Washington area. She spent several years honing her reporting and anchoring skills in Chattanooga,

Charlotte, and Cleveland, then Philadelphia at WCAU before joining NBC4 in 1989. Gentzler also filled in for vacationing news anchors on "The Today Show" and "NBC at Sunrise."


In her award-winning News 4 Your Health segments, Gentzler has brought viewers into hospital operating rooms, profiled medical breakthroughs, and shown the latest technology helping to save lives. Her reporting has brought her to Bosnia, Ecuador, and the Persian Gulf, where she reported live from the USNS Comfort, a navy hospital ship tending to U.S. troops.

Since May of 2014, Gentzler has been the lead reporter for a station-wide project on mental health called "Changing Minds." The project has garnered local and national recognition for highlighting a wide range of issues related to mental illness, a subject that can be challenging to cover in a TV news format. Changing Minds has taken us in many directions, but the goal is to reduce the stigma associated with mental illness.

Gentzler is also the spokesperson for the station's health-related community outreach activities such as the annual NBC4 Health and Fitness Expo.

Gentzler has won three local Emmy awards for reporting and anchoring as well as three other Emmy awards for news writing and reporting while in Cleveland. She holds a bachelor's degree in journalism from the University of Georgia.

She and her family live in Chevy Chase, MD.



BOARD OF GOVERNORS AWARD

This award reaches beyond those usually awarded for television news and production. The Board of Governors Award recognizes achievements by individuals, organizations or companies in community service or other worthwhile endeavors within the National Capital Chesapeake Bay's region. Historically, the Board of Governors Award is given for truly outstanding achievement and unique accomplishment of some duration and durability.



BRUCE JOHNSON Anchor/ Reporter WUSA9

Bruce Johnson has been an anchor and reporter for WUSA9 for 42 years.

Johnson currently anchors the weeknight 6 p.m. news and the 7 p.m. broadcast "Off Script with Bruce Johnson.

Bruce has won 21 Emmys including the prestigious Ted Yates Award, which is only given with a unanimous vote of the NATAS Board of Governors.

He's been inducted into the (SPJ) Society of Professional Journalist's Hall of Fame, the NATAS Silver Circle and the Washington D.C. Hall of Fame.

Johnson is a member of the National Press Club in Washington, DC and (NABJ) the National Association of Black Journalists.

Bruce has been honored with resolutions from the D.C. City Council and proclamations from D.C. mayors Anthony Williams and Muriel Bowser.

Bruce's community service and volunteer awards number well into the hundreds. His passion is the city's youth and it's shown in the stories he's told about their struggles and successes.

This veteran broadcast journalist has traveled the world on special assignment for WUSA9. Bruce has filed

special reports or documentaries from Moscow, Paris, Stockholm, Budapest, Tokyo, Dakar, Bangkok, earthquake ravaged Port-au-Prince, Haiti, Beijing, Shanghai, Rome and more recently Cuba.

Johnson authored two books. "Heart to Heart", is a moving account of how 12 men and women survived heart attacks then discovered new healthier lifestyles.

His second book is "All or Nothing the Victor Page story." It's an exclusive story of a star Georgetown University basketball player whose pro career was sabotaged by his past.

Bruce is married with three adult children, three grandsons, and Najee the family dog.

He's a graduate and noted alumnus of Northern Kentucky University with a degree in Political Science. In May Bruce was awarded an honorary doctorate degree by NKU where he delivered the commencement address. Bruce also has a Master's Degree in Public Affairs from the University of Cincinnati.






